

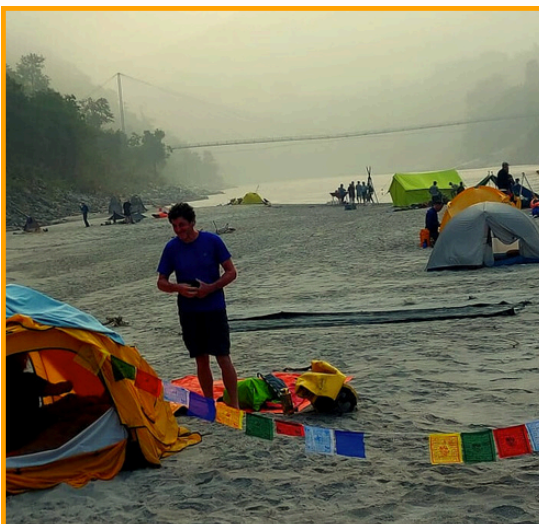


HIMALAYAN RUSH MULTI RIVERS KAYAKING TOUR

Following the opening ceremony of the Heritage Celebration, we will head on a special river expedition to paddle on five of Central Nepal's major rivers: Budi Gandaki, Trisuli, Marsyangdi, Seti, and Kali Gandaki."

This multi-river kayaking expedition offers a special opportunity to experience the central Nepal's whitewater. The adventure begins on the Budhi Gandaki River, setting the tone with exciting Class III+ to IV whitewater on remote, powerful rivers deep in the Himalayan foothills. Designed for intermediate to advanced paddlers seeking a multi-class kayaking adventure, Along the way, paddlers stay in scenic riverside camps and comfortable local lodges, with time to relax and connect with Nepal's landscapes and communities. The expedition is fully guided and road-supported, carefully designed to maximize time on the paddling while minimizing travel.

After experiencing the exhilarating rush & breathtaking scenery of mountain and completing the expedition, we will return to Kathmandu, where the celebration will conclude with the closing ceremony & Reception.



Itinerary

13- Nov– Travel to The Royal Beach Camp

Event Bus Departs from Kathmandu
Arrival at Royal Beach Camp, Registration & Settling In, Dinner, Campfire & Informal Gathering

14- Nov– Welcome Ceremony

16- Nov- Expedition Departure

River Expedition Briefing, Loading the Expedition Vehicle, Drive to the Budi Gandaki put-in , overnight at tea house.

17- Nov – Budi Gandaki River

Begin Paddle through remote gorges with stunning views of Mt. Manaslu (8,163 m) towering on the back drop.

18- Nov – Return to Royal Beach Camp

Continue paddling the Budi Gandaki around mid-afternoon arrive back at the Royal Beach Camp for a well-earned rest, hot showers, and camp comforts.

19- Nov – Upper Marsyangdi River

Drive to the Upper Marsyangdi. Afternoon paddling on fantastic Class III–IV whitewater, Evening riverside camping at the take out.

20- Nov – Lower Marsyangdi & Pokhara

Short drive to the Lower Marsyangdi, paddling enjoyable Class III rapids to Bimalnagar. Drive to Pokhara in the evening. Overnight Hotel in lakeside.

21- Nov – Upper Seti

Paddle the Upper Seti, a steep, technical Class III+ with Annapurna and Machhapuchhre as the backdrop. After kayaking, drive to Kali Gandaki.

22–24 Nov– Kali Gandaki River

Three days journey down the Kali Gandaki. Enjoy big Class III–IV rapids, sandy beaches, remote gorges, temples, villages, and interactions with locals. Final day drive back to Pokhara.

25 – Nov - Travel Pokhara to Kathmandu

26 - Nov - Leisure Day in Kathmandu

The day is free for rest ,shopping or sightseeing.

27 - Nov - Closing Ceremony & Reception

In the evening ceremony, we will conclude this adventure with a closing event and Nagarik Abinandan for our expedition guests.

28- Nov – Departure

Transfer to the airport for onward travel.

Cost: 2950 USD

Including:

- Heritage Celebration at The Royal Beach Camp
- Transportation: Including event & expedition
- 3 nights Hotel in Kathmandu
- River Expedition: Fully supported Expedition as per itinerary, raft support, River leader, safety boaters, kitchen crew, camping and kitchen equipment, all meals while on the river and our office team for back up.
- Closing Ceremony
