The Karnali River offers one of the most significant river expedition in the Himalayas - big volume, long sections of continuous and powerful rapids. This journey is complemented by hidden waterfalls, beautiful landscape, & rich wildlife. This expedition offers adventurous travelers a rare opportunity to experience world class Himalayan whitewater.

After experiencing the wild west Karnali's whitewater and completing the expedition, we will return to Kathmandu, where the celebration will conclude with the closing ceremony & Reception.

17 - Nov – Flight to Surkhet & Drive to the River

After breakfast, we board a domestic flight to Surkhet, our private vehicle and the crew will transfer us to the river put-in. By late afternoon, rafts and equipment are prepared, and we begin a short paddle downstream to our first riverside camp.

18- Nov- The Karnali

Today we spend approximately five hours on the river. In the afternoon, we enjoy a series of fun rapids before running our first major rapid Sweetness and Light.

19- Nov – Big Water

Full day of exciting whitewater, passing by Jungle ghat. Shortly downstream, we tackle Jailhouse Rock The afternoon float leads us to Scorpion Beach, our campsite for the night.

20- Nov – Rest Day

Rest day allows time to relax and enjoy the wild west surroundings, activities include beach volleyball, reading a book, learning to paddle a kayak, or taking a walk to a nearby village to experience local life.

21- Nov- The Game day

Today we encounter the most powerful whitewater of the expedition. The day begins with God's house rapid, followed by a Juicer and Flip 'n Strip & Red Rock Canyon.

22 Nov - More Splash

Another big water day complemented by beautiful scenery, passing by small settlement of remote villages.

23- Nov – Relaxed River Journey

This is a day to relax, enjoy calmer water beautiful scenery. Great option to kayak class II water.

24- Nov – Lower Karnali & Final Camp

We drift peacefully through the lower section of the Karnali, we passes through the fishermen villages, it's our opportunity to connecting with locals.

25- Nov – Take-Out & Return to Kathmandu

Marking the end of the river journey we reach Chisopani. From here, we drive to Nepalgunj for our return flight to Kathmandu.

26- Nov - Leisure Day in Kathmandu

The day is free for rest, shopping or sightseeing.

27- Nov Closing Ceremony & Reception

In the evening ceremony, we will conclude this adventure with a closing event and Nagarik Abinandan for our expedition guests.

28- Nov – Departure

Transfer to the airport for onward travel.
